Overview

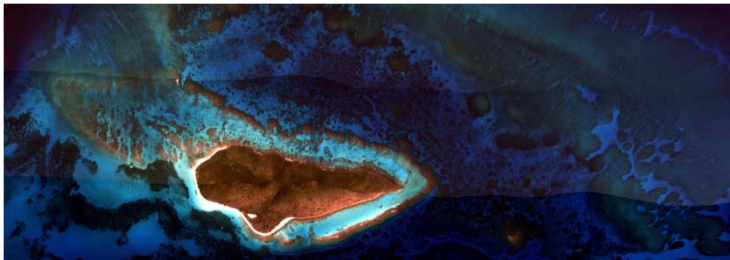


- **Natural, marine and cultural resource acquisition requirements are significant through 2014**
 - 15 total Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracts
 - \$147M total value
- **Effective use of small business and unrestricted contracts**
 - Mostly small business
- **Changes to overall strategy**
 - 3-year versus 5-year IDIQs
 - Multiple Award Contracts (MACs)

Natural Resources



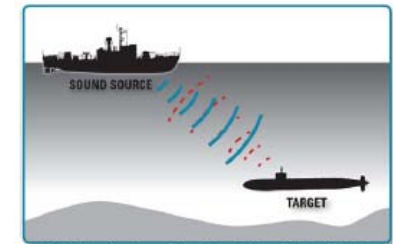
- **Threatened and endangered species surveys and consultations**
- **Integrated Natural Resource Management Plans (INRMPs)**
- **Wetland surveys & mitigation plans**
- **Remote sensing analysis and GIS mapping of natural resources features**
- **Wildlife & plant surveys**
- **Development of brochures for public outreach**
- **Invasive species consultations and control**
- **Bird Aircraft Strike Hazard (BASH) support**



Marine Resources



- **Range and training exercise compliance and planning**
 - Marine resource assessments (MRAs)
 - Density estimates
 - Mitigation and monitoring
 - Sonar and explosive effects analysis
 - Coastal Zone Management Act compliance
 - Endangered Species Act (ESA), Marine Mammal Protection Act (MMPA), and Essential Fish Habitat (EFH) compliance & consultation
- **Marine Resources Support Group (MRSG)**
 - Network of Navy technical experts
 - Consistency of products and services



Cultural Resources



- **Archaeological surveys**
- **Historic building and structure evaluations**
 - Mitigation for alteration and demolition
 - Preservation and re-use recommendations
- **Integrated Cultural Resources Management Plans (ICRMPs)**
- **Section 106 consultation assistance**



Current Contract Vehicles



- **Natural and Marine Resources**

- Use mix of small and large business fixed-price IDIQ service contract vehicles to accomplish work
- Use of Cooperative Agreements also a key tool

- **Cultural Resources**

- Use mix of small and large business IDIQ contract vehicles

FY11-14 Acquisition Strategy



- **Increasing workload to support Fleet operations and training**
 - Ranges and exercises
 - Marine mammal monitoring
 - Incidental Harassment Authorizations (IHAs), Letters of Authorization (LOAs), and Biological Evaluations (BEs)
- **Dredging permitting and sediment testing requirements**
- **Contracts will have a regional focus, however, they will include provisions for interoperability**
 - Most contracts will be available to all NAVFAC components
- **Mostly small business**
- **3-year duration**
- **Mix of single award and multiple award contracts (MACs)**

Summary



- **Marine resources workload is increasing**
 - Marine mammal monitoring
 - Mitigation
 - NEPA support
- **Natural & Cultural Resources workload is steady**
 - INRMP and ICRMP implementation
 - Mitigation requirements
