USING THE NECO "SEARCH SYNOPSIS" FUNCTION



- **Open and closed solicitations may be viewed.**
- **Search criteria and tips for a successful search include:**
 - **Solicitation Number**
 - Do not use hyphens or spaces. Can use a partial number or just UIC to expand or reduce list.
 - **Specified Date Range**
 - Allows selection of Business Opportunities posted today, yesterday, or within 7, 14, 21, 30, 45, 60 or 90 days of today.
 - **Transaction Purpose**
 - Types include advance notification, cancel (to be reissued), cancellation, change, draft, duplicate, information copy, reissue and replace.

USING THE NECO “SEARCH SYNOPSIS” FUNCTION



- **Search criteria and tips for a successful search (continued):**

- **Federal Supply Classification (FSC)**

- A link on the Business Opportunities page, “Search for a Federal Stock Code”, provides a list of Federal Supply Groups (FSGs) and the 4-digit FSC codes for each.

- **Commercial and Government Entity Code (CAGE)**

- This entry is for use by manufacturers whose part numbers begin with their CAGE code. Buyers will sometimes indicate a Vendor’s (Seller’s) part number. (NOT TYPICALLY USED BY NAVFAC.)

•Open/Closed Solicitations

- By default, solicitations are automatically archived once they close.
- All solicitations are removed from archived materials after six months.
- It is possible to view closed solicitations through an open solicitation search.
- Buyers have the option of choosing an archive date when posting.

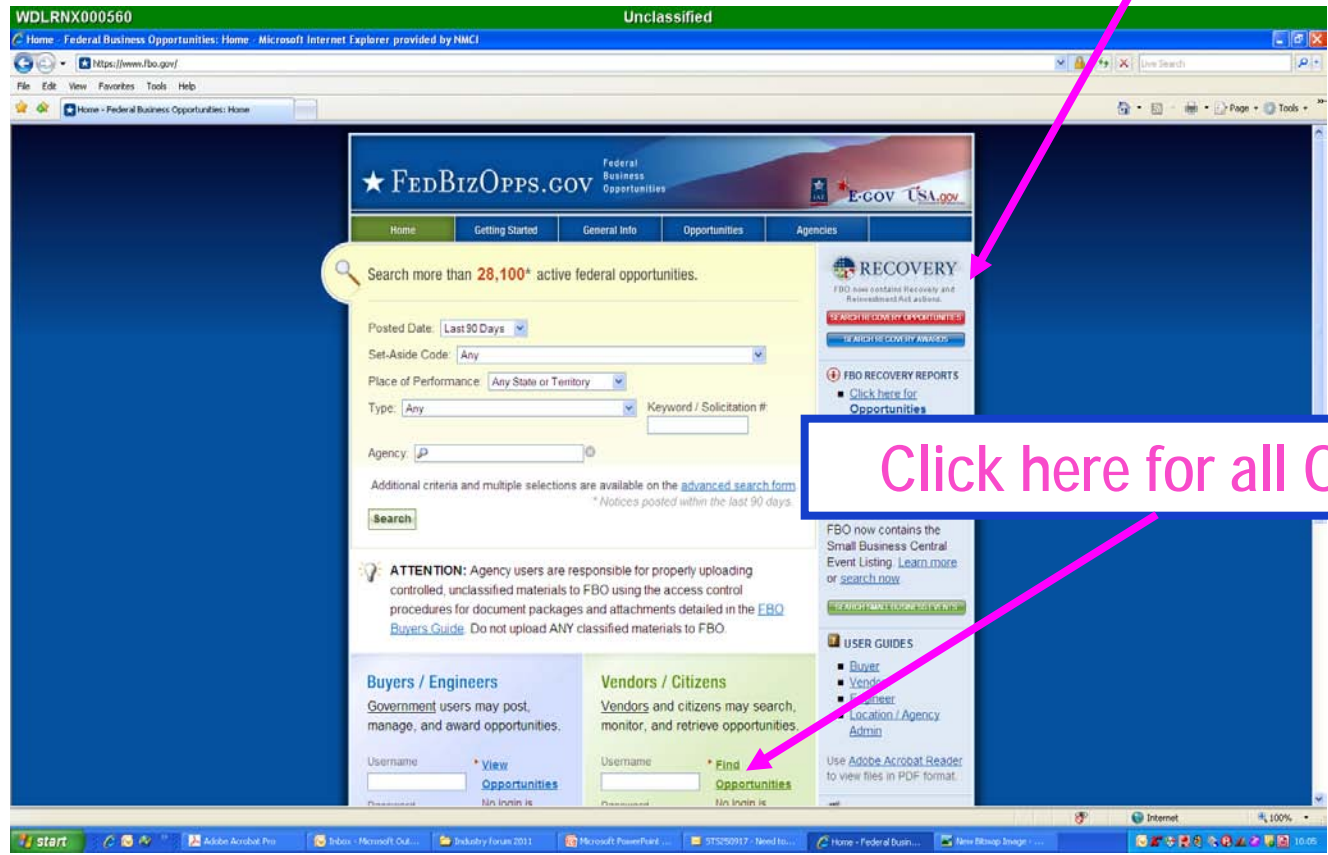

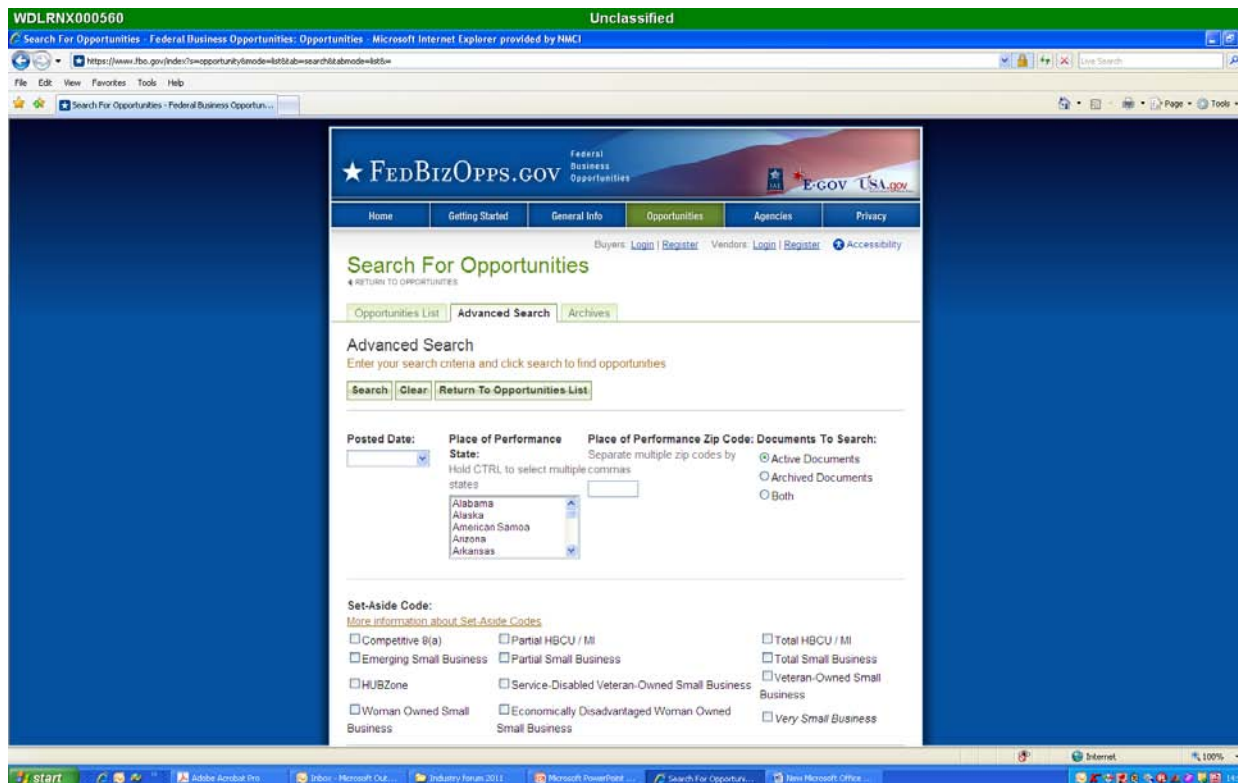
